

BSKC Secondary School Budget breakdown

The BSKC curriculum projects are designed to support and develop the following initiative areas across the school:

- Enterprise and entrepreneurial skills

The BSKC provides multiple outcomes from a small investment - £135 inc vat per team of three – and includes the school council development programme that develops a sponsorship development plan that should cover the entire costs of the project whilst maximising the effect of the project on positive school publicity.
